In the fourteen minutes talk, Magdalene covered the bullying and trolling children face at school, the injustice of those who are made to feel like outsiders and labelled as a 'lost cause.' She believes that "it's not only time to walk beside those kids but also to up our own game."

Magdalene says "Having the opportunity to give my TEDx talk was a dream come true. I spoke about 'why we must all be leaders', stemming from a personal experience and how the encouraging words my mum told me at the age of eleven after another episode of bullying at school.
